Biography Director:

After an early education in electro-mechanics, Kristof Hoornaert (1980, Belgium) eventually chose to study Audiovisual Arts in Ghent and Brussels. His first short film "KAÏN" premiered in the official competition of the 59th Berlin International Film Festival, where it got nominated for the Golden Bear. He also edited the short film "NUCLEAR WASTE" by Ukrainian filmmaker Myroslav Slaboshpytskiy, which premiered in the official competition of the 65th Locarno International Film Festival, where it won the Silver Leopard. The film got also nominated for the award "European Film Academy Short Film 2013". In 2013 he wrote, directed and produced his second short film "THE FALL" - a 17 minute short film that was shot in only 1 day. The film won several awards and got selected in more than 40 film festivals worldwide. "EMPIRE" is his latest short film: an audiovisual reflection on our modern civilization, captured in a real time plan-sequence shot. Currently he is preparing his first feature film "RESURRECTION" with Fobic Films.
